## Welcome to your new home.

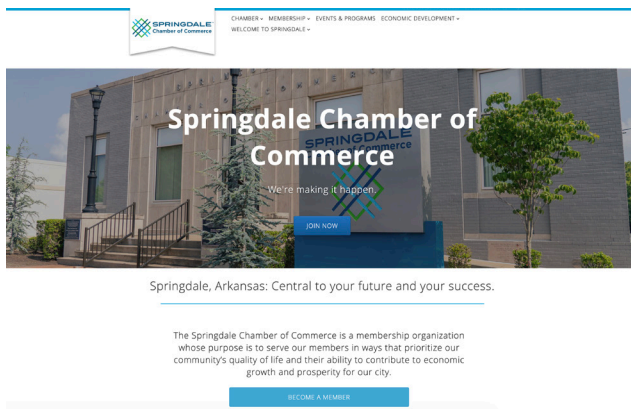
The Springdale Chamber of Commerce is here to help you settle in. This guide provides information you will need to get comfortable in our city.

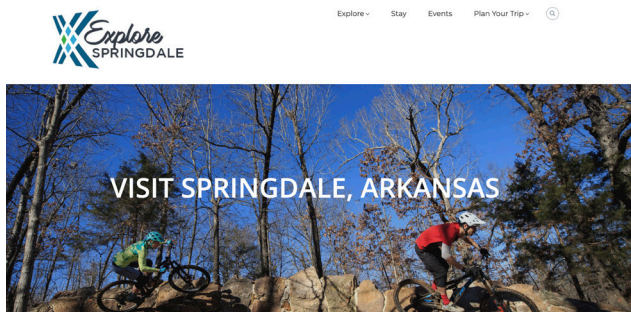

# HEALTH CARE

Healthcare is a priority in Springdale. Residents benefit from a wide-range of providers to meet their needs. From women's health to critical, pediatric, senior and specialty care, yours and your loved ones' well-being is in good hands.

## CRITICAL care

**Northwest Health** calls Springdale home. For more than 60 years, the largest healthcare system in Northwest Arkansas has provided the facilities, technology and training necessary to meet the growing medical needs of the region. The 222-bed acute care facility has over 300 physicians on staff with a wide range of medical specialties.

## PEDIATRIC care

The region's only hospital devoted exclusively to pediatric care, this state-of-the-art hospital delivers access to the vast resources of the **Arkansas Children's Hospital** team of medical specialists. The hospital offers the region's only pediatric emergency room, open 24/7.

**Willow Creek Women's Hospital** is one of the state's busiest birthing facilities. The hospital offers a wide range of services for women with 64 licensed beds.

## SPECIALTY care

- **Schmieding Center** provides adults in the second half of life with personalized education, services and healthcare to help them experience healthy aging and improve their quality of life.
- **Springdale Center for Health** is a Washington Regional outpatient clinic. The clinic provides Digital Screening Mammography, Bone Density, Digital X-Ray, Ultrasound and EKG Imaging.
- **Arisa Health/ Ozark Guidance** helps adults, children, and families live better lives through quality mental health services. Services range from counseling and educational programs to more intense levels of care.
- **Highlands Oncology** has been providing excellence in cancer care in Northwest Arkansas for decades with comprehensive programs enabling patients to see multiple specialists and support services all under one roof.
- **Mercy Northwest Springdale ER** This free standing emergency room in Springdale provides state-of-the-art emergency care, 24/7. The ER features a lab, X-ray, CT scan, 12 exam rooms, two triage rooms and one trauma room plus a medical helicopter pad.

## Ozark Highlands Nature Center

Opened December 2020, the **J.B. and Johnelle Hunt Family Ozark Highlands Nature Center** is Springdale's newest attraction. This 32,000 square foot facility on over 61 acres is the newest place to learn about nature and outdoor recreation in Springdale. Bring the family to see live wildlife and fish and interact with hands-on, high-tech exhibits!



## Downtown Springdale

If you need a place to shop, eat, stroll, bike or be in community, look no further than **downtown Springdale!** Explore the bakeries, boutiques, taprooms and taquerias, and enjoy the new Outdoor Dining District, allowing you to carry refreshments from one location to another. Watch for monthly concerts in the warmer months and other unique events.







## Shiloh Museum of Ozark History

The **Shiloh Museum of Ozark History** features exhibits, six historical buildings and a research library that tells the stories of the original settlers of Northwest Arkansas.

## Arkansas & Missouri Railroad

The **Arkansas & Missouri Railroad** operates an excursion train that regularly departs from Springdale and takes passengers through some of the most scenic parts of the Ozark Boston Mountains.



## Special Events

Springdale hosts a few annual events that attract many visitors year-round, including the **Hogeye Marathon & Relays** every spring, **Street Dinner** on Emma Ave. in June, **Rodeo of the Ozarks** in the summer, **Ozarktober** every October, the **Dia de los Muertos** celebration every November, **Christmas on the Creek** late November, and more!



# SPORTS PARADISE

The sports scene in Springdale is a home run. Our all-star community boasts top-notch professional, high school and recreational programs with state-of-the-art facilities. Athletes and fans feel right at home in our sports paradise, and the cycling amenities are perfect for families, joy riders and thrill-seekers of all ages.

## Razorback Greenway

Stretching from Fayetteville to Bella Vista, the **Razorback Greenway** runs right through the heart of all the major Northwest Arkansas cities. These 40 miles are paved with two lanes to accommodate cyclists, joggers and walkers alike and link together dozens of popular community destinations and residential areas.

## Mountain Biking

Near Bayyari Park, you'll discover **Fitzgerald Mountain!** Ribbons of dirt and stretches of boulders were expertly knit together to provide anything a beginner or thrill-seeking mountain biker needs!

## Arvest Ballpark

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals, AA affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, calls Springdale's award-winning Arvest Ballpark home for 69 home games each summer.

## Rodeo of the Ozarks

The **Rodeo of the Ozarks** is a Springdale classic event held every year since World War II. Parsons Stadium hosts the Rodeo as well as several other events throughout the year, including demolition derbies and carnivals.

## The Jones Center

**The Jones Center** is a recreation, education and event center for families located in downtown Springdale! The Center boasts a year-round ice rink, junior-Olympic sized lap pool, swimming pool with a slide, world-class bike park, basketball courts, fitness center and indoor track.



A wide variety of outdoor and indoor activities and leagues for youth and adults are offered here through Springdale Parks & Recreation!



## C.L. and Willie George Park

George Park (4023 Hylton Rd.) contains four youth baseball fields, four batting cages, a football field, six soccer fields, lighted tennis courts, dog park, two pavilions with restrooms, a splash pad and playgrounds.

## More Parks

- Bayyari Park (2300 Deer Valley St.) pump track, pavilion, playground, restrooms and trailhead to Fitzgerald Mountain biking trails
- Bobby Hopper Park (981 E. Huntsville Ave.) pavilion, playground, two soccer fields and restrooms
- Forrest Bowen Park (4322 N. Oak St.) large playground, walking trail, pavilion, outdoor exercise equipment, volleyball court
- Luther George Park (300 Park St.) paved walking loop, pavilion, picnic tables, playgrounds and restrooms
- Murphy Park (501 S. Pleasant St.) pond, sand volleyball court, playground, paved trail
- Shaw Family Park (7341 W. Downum Rd.) tennis courts, splash pad, extreme fitness area, two playgrounds, dog park, five ponds (one for fishing), three biking/walking trails, two pavilions, restrooms and a large natural area

# PARKS & REC

## Springdale Recreation Center

The Springdale Recreation Center (1906 Cambridge St.) is home to six indoor basketball/volleyball courts, two indoor soccer fields, group fitness areas and weight training equipment!

## Randal Tyson Recreation Complex

Tyson Park (4303 Watkins) includes a paved trail, sand volleyball court, two **Miracle League** fields, three adult softball fields, four batting cages, four little league baseball fields, three high school sized baseball fields, three horseshoe pits, three playgrounds, four soccer/football fields, six lighted tennis courts, two basketball courts, a dog park and a splash pad!

## J.B. Hunt Park

Hunt Park (1955 Fleming Dr.), a 200-acre site, features **Lake Springdale**, two adult softball fields, four youth softball fields, two playgrounds, two paved trails, an 18-hole disc golf course, the **Thunder Chicken** mountain bike trail and a pump track!

## Aquatic Center

The Springdale Aquatic Center (1100 Watson Dr.) has two slides, lap lanes, and diving boards! Season-long tickets can be purchased as well as individual day tickets.
